Washington University's total **day school enrollment** for the **Fall 2012** semester is **12,455** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester. An additional **1,662** students are enrolled in evening and part-time programs, bringing the **total University enrollment** to **14,117**.

Undergraduate students: **6,483 undergraduates** are enrolled in day school divisions and **820** in evening and part-time programs.

Graduate students: **5,972 graduate and professional students** are enrolled in day school divisions and **842** in evening and part-time programs.

Total **degree-seeking enrollments** for Fall 2012: **12,079 full-time** and **1,238 part-time** students.

Gender and Ethnicity

As a university, we continue to enroll fairly equal numbers of women (7274, 51.5%) and men (6843, 48.5%). These percentages hold true for both undergraduate and graduate student populations.

Over 40% of WU students identify with a non-White ethnic or racial group or international population. New federal reporting categories have enabled us to capture more detail on the race and ethnicity of our non-White, multiracial and international students. Among those students reporting racial and ethnic affiliations (noting that students are able to report an affiliation with more than one group), 4.2% are Hispanic or Latino, 0.8% are American Indian or Alaska Native, 22.7% are Asian, 6.9% are Black or African American, and 0.1% are Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; 55% of our students are White and not multi-racial (10.9% are unreported). The international student enrollment is now 15.3% of our total enrollment.

New this year is an additional table of Graduate Degree Programs. While student headcount by "prime" school and division is critical data for some areas of the University it does not tell the whole story at the graduate level. Graduate Degree Programs Fall 2012

The graduate programs at Washington University reflect a complexity of relationships between the schools which cannot be fully described in terms of student enrollment by the "prime" division in which the student is classified. Total program enrollment will exceed the unduplicated headcount of graduate students because some students are enrolled in multiple programs.
