Washington University's total **day school enrollment** for the **Fall 2015** semester is **13,286** per data captured at the 10<sup>th</sup> week of the semester. An additional **1,556** students are enrolled in evening and part-time programs, bringing the **total University enrollment to 14,842**.

Undergraduate students: **6,841 undergraduates** are enrolled in day school divisions and **719** in evening and part-time programs.

Graduate students: **6,445 graduate and professional students** are enrolled in day school divisions and **837** in evening and part-time programs.

Total **degree-seeking enrollments** for Fall 2015: **12,856 full-time** and **1,310 part-time** students.

#### Gender and Ethnicity

As a university, we continue to enroll fairly equal numbers of women (7525, 51%) and men (7317, 49%). There are only slight differences between the undergraduate (52% women, 48% men) and graduate (49% women, 51% men) student populations.

Over 40% of WU students identify with a non-White ethnic or racial group or international population. The federal reporting categories now enable us to capture more detail on the race and ethnicity of our non-White, multiracial and international students. Among those students reporting racial and ethnic affiliations (noting that students are able to report an affiliation with more than one group), 5.94% are Hispanic or Latino, 0.99% are American Indian or Alaska Native, 30.97% are Asian, 7.61% are Black or African American, and 0.13% are Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; 55.40% of our students are White and not multi-racial (7.53% are unreported). International students represent 19.05% of our total enrollment.

## Graduate Degree Programs Fall 2015

Total program enrollment will exceed the unduplicated headcount of graduate students because some students are enrolled in multiple programs.
