Washington University's total **day school enrollment** for the **Fall 2016** semester is **13,665** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester. An additional **1,490** students are enrolled in evening and part-time programs, bringing the **total University enrollment to 15,155**.

Undergraduate students: **6,941 undergraduates** are enrolled in day school divisions and **663** in evening and part-time programs.

Graduate students: **6,724 graduate and professional students** are enrolled in day school divisions and **827** in evening and part-time programs.

Total **degree-seeking enrollments** for Fall 2016: **13,224 full-time** and **1,290 part-time** students.

Gender and Ethnicity

As a university, we continue to enroll fairly equal numbers of women (7789, 51%) and men (7366, 49%). There are only slight differences between the undergraduate (53% women, 47% men) and graduate (49% women, 51% men) student populations.

Over 40% of WU students identify with a non-White ethnic or racial group or international population. The federal reporting categories now enable us to capture more detail on the race and ethnicity of our non-White, multiracial and international students. Among those students reporting racial and ethnic affiliations (noting that students are able to report an affiliation with more than one group), 6.61% are Hispanic or Latino, 1.10% are American Indian or Alaska Native, 30.60% are Asian, 8.48% are Black or African American, and 0.21% are Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; 54.24% of our students are White and not multi-racial (7.92% are unreported). International students represent 19.35% of our total enrollment.

Graduate Degree Programs Fall 2016

The graduate programs at Washington University reflect a complexity of relationships between the schools which cannot be fully described in terms of student enrollment by the "prime" division in which the student is classified. The figures below indicate program enrollment within each school for the degrees certified by their faculty. Total program enrollment will exceed the unduplicated headcount of graduate students because some students are enrolled in multiple programs.
