Washington University's total **day school enrollment** for the **Fall 2018** semester is **14,532** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester. An additional **1,405** students are enrolled in evening and part-time programs, bringing the **total University enrollment** to **15,937**.

Undergraduate students: **7,169 undergraduates** are enrolled in day school divisions and **622** in evening and part-time programs.

Graduate students: **7,363 graduate and professional students** are enrolled in day school divisions and **783** in evening and part-time programs.

Total degree-seeking enrollments for Fall 2018: 14,126 full-time and 1,258 part-time students.

Gender and Ethnicity

As a university, we continue to enroll fairly equal numbers of women (8446, 53%) and men (7491, 47%). This is true across the undergraduate (4158 women, 3633 men) and graduate (4288 women, 3858 men) student populations.

Nearly 50% of WU students identify with a non-White ethnic or racial group or international population. The federal reporting categories now enable us to capture more detail on the race and ethnicity of our non-White, multiracial and international students. Among those students reporting racial and ethnic affiliations (noting that students are able to report an affiliation with more than one group), 7.59% are Hispanic or Latino, 1.16% are American Indian or Alaska Native, 31.28% are Asian, 10.51% are Black or African American, and 0.35% are Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; 50.86% of our students are White and not multi-racial (8.41% are unreported). International students represent 21.61% of our total enrollment.
