Washington University's total **day school enrollment** for the **Fall 2019** semester is **14,740** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester. An additional **1,551** students are enrolled in evening and part-time programs, bringing the **total University enrollment to 16,291**.

Undergraduate students: **7,168 undergraduates** are enrolled in day school divisions and **690** in evening and part-time programs.

Graduate students: **7,572 graduate and professional students** are enrolled in day school divisions and **861** in evening and part-time programs.

Total **degree-seeking enrollments** for Fall 2019: **14,290 full-time** and **1,413 part-time** students.

Gender and Ethnicity

As a university, we continue to enroll fairly equal numbers of women (8700, 53%) and men (7591, 47%). This is true across the undergraduate (4204 women, 3654 men) and graduate (4496 women, 3937 men) student populations.

Nearly 50% of WU students identify with a non-White ethnic or racial group or international population. The federal reporting categories now enable us to capture more detail on the race and ethnicity of our non-White, multiracial and international students. Among those students reporting racial and ethnic affiliations (noting that students are able to report an affiliation with more than one group), 7.81% are Hispanic or Latino, 1.29% are American Indian or Alaska Native, 34.50% are Asian, 10.48% are Black or African American, and 2.58% are Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; 47.57% of our students are White and not multi-racial (7.42% are unreported). International students represent 23.61% of our total enrollment.

Graduate Degree Programs Fall 2019
