





Washington University's total enrollment for the **Spring 2014** semester is **13,558** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester on March 24th.

We have 7,238 students enrolled in undergraduate programs this spring: 6,442 are in the day school divisions and 796 are in our undergraduate evening and part-time programs.

Our graduate student enrollment this spring is 6,320 which includes 5,539 students in the day school divisions and professional programs, and 781 students in evening and part-time programs at the graduate level.

Tables outlining Total Enrollment by School, enrollment in the Graduate Degree Programs, and our totals for the 2013-2014 Academic Year are printed on the following pages.

## Graduate Degree Programs Spring 2014

The graduate programs at Washington University reflect a complexity of relationships between the schools which cannot be fully described in terms of student enrollment by the "prime" division in which the student is classified. The figures below indicate program enrollment within each school for the degrees certified by their faculty. Total program enrollment will exceed the unduplicated headcount of graduate students because some students are enrolled in multiple programs.
