Washington University's total enrollment for the **Spring 2016** semester is **14,212** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester on March 25th.

We have 7,359 students enrolled in undergraduate programs this spring: 6,661 are in the day school divisions and 698 are in our undergraduate evening and part-time programs.

Our graduate student enrollment this spring is 6,853 which includes 5,989 students in the day school divisions and professional programs, and 864 students in evening and part-time programs at the graduate level.

## Graduate Degree Programs Spring 2016
