Washington University's total enrollment for the **Spring 2020** semester is **15,229** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester on March 20<sup>th</sup>.

We have 7,606 students enrolled in undergraduate programs this spring: 6,950 are in the day school divisions and 656 are in our undergraduate evening and part-time programs.

Our graduate student enrollment this spring is 7,623 which includes 6,813 students in the day school divisions and professional programs, and 810 students in evening and part-time programs at the graduate level.

## Graduate Degree Programs Spring 2020

The graduate programs at Washington University reflect a complexity of relationships between the schools which cannot be fully described in terms of student enrollment by the "prime" division in which the student is classified. Total program enrollment will exceed the unduplicated headcount of graduate students because some students are enrolled in multiple programs.
