Washington University's total enrollment for the **Spring 2013** semester is **13,381** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester on March 25th.

We have 7,067 students enrolled in undergraduate programs this spring: 6,343 are in the day school divisions and 724 are in our undergraduate evening and part-time programs.

Our graduate student enrollment this spring is 6,314 which includes 5,498 students in the day school divisions and professional programs, and 816 students in evening and part-time programs at the graduate level.

## Graduate Degree Programs Spring 2013

Total program enrollment will exceed the unduplicated headcount of graduate students because some students are enrolled in multiple programs.
