Washington University's total **day school enrollment** for the **Fall 2014** semester is **12,882** per data captured at the 10th week of the semester. An additional **1,621** students are enrolled in evening and part-time programs, bringing the **total University enrollment** to **14,503**.

Undergraduate students: **6,686 undergraduates** are enrolled in day school divisions and **781** in evening and part-time programs.

Graduate students: **6,196 graduate and professional students** are enrolled in day school divisions and **840** in evening and part-time programs.

Total **degree-seeking enrollments** for Fall 2014: **12,499 full-time** and **1,315 part-time** students.

Gender and Ethnicity

As a university, we continue to enroll fairly equal numbers of women (7345, 51%) and men (7158, 49%). There are only slight differences between the undergraduate (52% women, 48% men) and graduate (49% women, 51% men) student populations.

Over 40% of WU students identify with a non-White ethnic or racial group or international population. The federal reporting categories now enable us to capture more detail on the race and ethnicity of our non-White, multiracial and international students. Among those students reporting racial and ethnic affiliations (noting that students are able to report an affiliation with more than one group), 5% are Hispanic or Latino, 0.8% are American Indian or Alaska Native, 25% are Asian, 6.6% are Black or African American, and 0.1% are Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; 52.9% of our students are White and not multi-racial (9.9% are unreported). International students represent 17% of our total enrollment.

Graduate Degree Programs Fall 2014
